Re: Construction of modal filters on Belvedere Road and Sanderstead Road, at the junction with Lea Bridge Road

Dear Resident/ Business Owner,

As part of our highway improvement works for Lea Bridge Road, we are writing to let you know that construction of two modal filters will start on Monday 6 February 2017 to close the following junctions:

- Belvedere Road and Lea Bridge Road
- Sanderstead Road and Lea Bridge Road.

The modal filters will allow cyclists and pedestrians to travel through the junction, closing access through the junctions to motorists. Road users will have access to properties on these roads through alternative routes.

Construction will largely be carried out between 8am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday, and will take approximately four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

These works aim to improve access for walking and cycling, improve road safety, prevent non local traffic from cutting through residential streets, and generally improve the look and feel of the area.
