Dear Resident / Business owner,

RE: Forest Road E17 road resurfacing work – Temporary road closures and parking restrictions

I am writing to let you know that road resurfacing work will take place on Forest Road between Chatham Road and Palmerston Road from **Monday 23 October**. The work is expected to take three days, depending on fine weather conditions, and should be completed by Thursday 26 July.

Each day, in order to carry out the resurfacing in a safe and efficient manner, a temporary closure of Forest Road between 9am and 4pm will be made at its junctions with Blackhorse Road and Chatham Road. This closure will affect eastbound traffic only; westbound traffic will be maintained on Forest Road past the working area down to the Blackhorse Road junction.

A temporary closure of Wellington Road will also be necessary at its junction with Forest Road between 9am and 4pm, with alternative access for vehicles via Canning Road.

This work is part of ongoing changes on Forest Road, and aims to improve road safety and access for walking and cycling. We sent you a letter last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in March 2016, and when the works would start. To allow us to carry out the road works safely and on time, please avoid parking in the area. Look out for signs and cones to avoid parking in the wrong place as illegally parked vehicles will get penalty notices and may be removed - see reverse for details. Parking will be available on the side roads, so please use this space instead.

Please bear with us while we make these improvements to the area. Our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum and we will post regular construction updates online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/forest-road/construction.
