RE: Blended 'Copenhagen' crossing on Queens Road, E11

As part of our highway improvement works for the Leytonstone Town Centre scheme we are writing to let you know that work on Queens Road at its junction with Grove Green Road will begin on Monday 7 November.

These works aim to improve access for cycling and walking, improve road safety, reduce traffic volumes and generally improve the look and feel of the area. You would have previously received a leaflet outlining the results from the public consultation held in January 2016 and when the works would be happening. This leaflet can also be found online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/leytonstone-town-centre/public-consultation-results.

A new blended 'Copenhagen' crossing to prioritise pedestrians crossing the road will be constructed in Queens Road at its junction with Grove Green Road.

Work will begin on Monday 7 November 2016 and will be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday to Saturday. To do the works quickly and safely, we need to temporarily close Queens Road at its junction with Grove Green Road and this should take approximately two weeks to complete.
