**ROAD RESURFACING – MARKHOUSE ROAD E17
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

Road resurfacing is due to be carried out along Markhouse Road from Tuesday 29th August to Thurs 31st August, between Queens Road and Lea Bridge Road. Footways will remain open at all times, and the road will be fully closed between Wetherden Street and Verulam Avenue

In order to carry out the resurfacing works a temporary closure of Samantha Close, Theydon Street and Boundary Road will be in place from 8pm – 5am. Traffic and buses will be diverted via Lea Bridge Road, Hoe Street and Selborne Road.

There will be some noise from the machinery being used during the resurfacing work however, where possible, we will not use pneumatic breakers after 11pm to minimise the level of excess noise. Whilst we appreciate that this is an inconvenience, we hope that you will bear with us so we can return the roads to normal as soon as possible.

Temporary waiting restrictions will be in force during the above hours of work to restrict parking in and around the working areas. Signage indicating the temporary parking restrictions will be displayed on site. Please take note of these restrictions, as where vehicles are found to be illegally parked, the Council's parking enforcement contractor will issue a penalty notice and may relocate the vehicle (see reverse for details).

Your help in observing these temporary parking restrictions would be appreciated. I apologise for any inconvenience caused by the works. In the meantime if you need any more information regarding the works do please contact me as above.

The diversion route for all vehicles is shown on the attached plan.

Parking penalty charges

Penalty notice - £130.00 (discounted to £65.00 if paid within 14 days of issue) details of payment will be on the back of the ticket.

Removal of vehicles and impounded – a charge of £65.00 for the Penalty notice and £200.00 for the release of the vehicle to be paid within the first 24 hours, after every 24 hour period a storage charge of £40.00 will be added. Collection of Impounded vehicles and payments for the release of a vehicle are to be made at the following address.
