**ROAD RESURFACING – MARKHOUSE ROAD E17
CHANGES TO ROAD CLOSURE DATES**

Due to adverse weather in the latter part of Tuesday night, and the forecast rain on Wednesday night, we have taken the decision to delay the Markhouse Road resurfacing works. These works will now recommence overnight on **Thursday 31st August** and be completed on **Friday 1st September**. These dates will also be subject to weather conditions.

As previously planned the road will be fully closed between Wetherden Street and Verulam Avenue, and footways will remain open at all times

In order to carry out the resurfacing works a temporary closure of Samantha Close, Theydon Street and Boundary Road will be in place from 8pm – 5am. Traffic and buses will be diverted via Lea Bridge Road, Hoe Street and Selborne Road.

The majority of noisy work has been completed on Tuesday 29th August, however, some smaller noisy work may be required. We aim to complete all noisy work before 11pm, but this may not always be possible. Whilst we appreciate that this is an inconvenience, we hope that you will bear with us so we can return the roads to normal as soon as possible.

If you need any more information regarding the works do please contact me as above. The diversion route for all vehicles remains the same and is shown on the attached plan.
