Dear Resident / Business owner,

**RE: Markhouse Road overnight closure - road resurfacing between South Grove and Boundary Road**

I am writing to inform you that we will be resurfacing Markhouse Road between South Grove and Boundary Road. This work will be completed at night, and start on **Monday 27 March** for 2 weeks between 8pm and 5am, Monday to Friday.

During the work, there will be some temporary road changes. During the hours of construction, Markhouse Road will be closed from South Grove to Lea Bridge Road and the following side roads at the junction with Markhouse Road:

- Markhouse Ave
- Low Hall Lane
- Ringwood Road
- Downsfield Road
- Queens Road
- Acacia Road
- Verulam Ave (one-way working revoked – see below)
- Boundary Road
- Samantha Close (for approximately 2 hours)
- Farmilo Road
- Theydon Street
- Wetherden Street

Traffic will be diverted via Lea Bridge Road, Hoe Street and Selborne Road. Residential access will be maintained via Station Road, Queens Road, Hoe Street or Lea Bridge Road. The one way working on Verulam Ave will be revoked so residents can drive into and exit towards Station Road.

Residents will still have access to Samantha Close, Theydon Street, Wetherden Street, Sybourn Street and Harris Street from Lea Bridge Road only.

There will be some noise from the machinery being used during the resurfacing work however, where possible we will aim to complete the noisiest work before 11pm to minimise the disturbance to residents. While we appreciate that this is an inconvenience, we hope that you will bear with us so we can return the roads to normal as soon as possible.

To allow us to carry out the road work safely and on time, please avoid parking in the area and if you are planning to make any journeys during the time of the work please make arrangements to park vehicles outside the limits of the closures. Please look out for signs and cones to avoid parking in the wrong place as illegally parked vehicles (between the hours of **7pm and 5am** will get penalty notices and vehicles will be towed – see reverse for details.
