Dear Resident / business owner,

RE: Theydon Street blended crossing – Temporary road closure

I am writing to let you know that work to construct a blended 'Copenhagen' crossing on Theydon Street, at its junction with Markhouse Road will start on Tuesday 24 October and is estimated to be completed by 7 November 2017 however every effort will be made to complete the works earlier if possible.

The blended 'Copenhagen' crossing is designed to slow down vehicles when entering or exiting the side road and encourage vehicles to give way to pedestrians crossing the road, reinforcing the rules of the Highway Code.

Work will be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday and will take approximately two weeks, weather permitting. To complete the works quickly and safely, we will need to temporarily close Theydon Street during the works and whilst we appreciate that this is an inconvenience, access will be maintained via Wetherden Street, and Harris Street.

Theydon Street is changing

At the completion of the work to construct a blended crossing, Theydon Street will be changed from two-way vehicle movements to only allowing one-way vehicle movements in a southwesterly direction, permitting entry from Markhouse Road only. Signage will be installed at the exit of Theydon Street (at the junction with Hibbert Road), stating "No Entry, except for cycles". Advanced notice of the final change will be given to local residents and businesses via on street notice boards and by letter prior to the change being made permanent and enforceable to allow for a period of adjustment to the new road layout.

The one-way on Theydon Street forms part of the Markhouse Road improvements. The changes to Markhouse Road aim to improve the road for people walking and cycling, improve road safety, reduce traffic speeds and generally improve the look and feel of the area. To keep the works on track and minimise disruption for everyone using this junction, we are asking local residents and businesses to avoid parking in the works area until the work has finished. 'No parking' signs and cones will be placed in the area so please look out for these before you park – parking will still be available so please use alternative parking places during the works period. Please avoid parking in the wrong place as penalty notices may be issued to illegally parked vehicles and they may also be removed.

Theydon Street Works: Parking and Penalty Notice Information

If you suspect your vehicle may have been removed, you should contact TRACE on 0845 206 8602, who should be able to confirm if your vehicle has been relocated or removed to a pound.

Penalty notice - £130.00 (discounted to £65.00 if paid within 14 days of issue) detail of payment will be on the back of the ticket.

Removal of vehicles and impounded – a charge of £65.00 for the Penalty notice and £200.00 for the release of the vehicle to be paid within the first 24 hours, after every 24 hour period a storage charge of £40.00 will be added. Collection of Impounded vehicles and payments for the release of a vehicle are to be made at the following address.
