**RE: Construction update for new modal filter and zebra crossing - Langthorne Road E11**

As part of our highway improvement works for the Leyton Town Centre scheme we are writing to let you know that the following work will start on Monday 30 January:

- Construction of a modal filter on Langthorne Road, between Trelawn Street and Grove Green Road. The modal filter (road closures) will only allow cycles and pedestrian to travel through this area, will provide new pedestrian pavement, a cycle track, soft landscaping, informal street furniture, and new bike stands. Access to properties for residents and emergency services will continue to be available via Trelawn Street and other nearby streets.
- Construction of a raised table and road marking a zebra crossing on Grove Green Road. A raised table involves raising the road to pavement level to encourage vehicles to slow down and improve pedestrian access to the local area.

These works aim to improve access for walking and cycling, improve road safety, reduce traffic volumes and generally improve the look and feel of the area. You would have recently received an update leaflet outlining the results from the public consultation held in January 2016 and when the works would start. Construction will largely be carried out between the hours of 8am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday and will take approximately six weeks to complete, weather permitting.

We will continue to monitor all of your feedback and suggestions and will run safety checks to make sure the scheme is performing as expected.
