## Construction of a blended 'Copenhagen' crossing on Dyers Hall Road

I am writing to let you know that work to construct a new blended 'Copenhagen' crossing on Dyers Hall Road, at its junction with Grove Green Road will start on **Monday 13 February**.

The blended 'Copenhagen' crossing design prioritises pedestrians at junctions, improves access for walking and cycling, and improves road safety.

We sent you a leaflet last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in January 2016, and when the works would start. You can find this leaflet online at www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/leytonstone-town-centre/public-consultation-results.

Work will take place between 8am and 5pm, Monday to Saturday, and will take around two weeks to complete, weather permitting. We will construct the blended 'Copenhagen' crossing in two halves to maintain access for vehicles and pedestrians. Temporary traffic management will be in place during this time to minimise disruption to travel.
