Dear Resident,

RE: Construction of speed humps on Haldan Road

I am writing to let you know that we are replacing the road cushions on Haldan Road between Winchester Road and Newbury Road with full road width speed humps. This work will start on **Monday 27 March 2017** and should take two days to complete, weather permitting.

During the work, there will be some temporary road changes as follows:

- Local access to Haldan Road will be available via Newbury Road and Winchester Road. During hours of work, residents will be able to access properties westbound from Winchester Road to minimise disruption.
- Parking suspended on Haldan Road between Winchester Road and Newbury Road - please look out for cones and advisory signs.
- Pedestrians will still be able to walk along the street as normal.

These works are part of the ongoing improvement to Highams Park Town Centre, and aim to improve road safety and access for walking and cycling. We sent you a leaflet last year explaining the results from the public consultation held in June and July 2016, and when the work would start. Work will usually take place between 8am and 5pm over the two days, weather permitting. The road will go back to normal outside of these times. To allow us to carry out the road works safely and on time, please avoid parking in the area. Look out for signs and cones to avoid parking in the wrong place as illegally parked vehicles will get penalty notices and they may be removed - see reverse for details.

Please bear with us during construction so we can make these improvements to the area as soon as possible. Our contractors will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum and we will post regular construction updates online at <http://www.enjoywalthamforest.co.uk/work-in-your-area/highams-park-town-centre/construction-update/>.
