Dear Residents/ Businesses,

**RE: Shernhall Street – road resurfacing**

As part of our ongoing highway improvement works in Shernhall Street I am writing to let you know that road resurfacing works will take place in Shernhall Street between Prospect Hill and Raglan Road from Monday 14 November 2016. This work should take two weeks to complete (weather permitting) and will take place between 9.30am and 3.30pm, Monday to Friday. During this time there will be limited access to this section of Shernhall Street and some residents will need to access their property through an alternative route. Below I have outlined when and where the work is taking place and information on the best way to access some of the roads affected by the work.

**Week 1**

On **Monday 14 November** we will begin resurfacing and installing a raised table at the junction of Church Hill Road and Church Lane which involves raising the road to pavement level to encourage vehicles to slow down when approaching the junction. During this time Shernhall Street will be closed to all vehicles between Prospect Hill and Brookfield Avenue, and there will be no vehicle access to this section of Shernhall Street from the side roads except for emergency vehicles. Pedestrians will still be able to walk along the street as normal.

**Week 2**

On **Monday 21 November** we will begin resurfacing Shernhall Street between Brookfield Avenue and Raglan Road. During the work (between 9.30am and 3.30pm), this section of Shernhall Street will be closed to vehicles and there will be no access from the side roads except for emergency vehicles.

- Between **Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 November** we will resurface the section between Brookfield Avenue and Barrett Road. To access these streets we ask that residents use Lea Bridge Road, Oliver Road and Raglan Road.
- **Between Wednesday 23 and Friday 25 November** we will resurface the section between Oliver Road and Raglan Road. To access these streets we ask that residents use Hoe Street, Brookfield Avenue and Barrett Road.

Advance warning signs and temporary diversion signs will be placed in the area to let drivers know that work is taking place and to prevent congestion. Parking will be suspended on Shernhall Street between Prospect Hill and Eastern Road and at the first 30 metres of the adjoining side roads during the two week period.

To keep the works on track, we are asking local residents and businesses to avoid parking in the area until the work has finished. "No parking" signs and cones will be placed in the area and if necessary, penalty notices will be issued and as a last resort vehicles will be removed and impounded if they are parked in a space that obstructs works. You can find contact details for the Council's parking enforcement contractors and details of their charges overleaf, should you need them. Parking will still be available in the adjacent

roads during the works, so please use this space instead.
