Dear Resident / Business owner,

RE: Ashville Road / Grove Green Road junction

As part of our highway improvement works for the Leyton Town Centre scheme we are writing to let you know that works to complete the Linear Park along the A12 border will begin at the Ashville Road and Grove Green Road junction on Tuesday 19th March.

These works are part of the Enjoy Waltham Forest programme which aim to improve road safety, access for walking and cycling, reduce traffic volumes and improve the look and feel of the area. You will have received a letter in October 2018 outlining the Linear Park plans and when the works would be happening.

The current road safety improvements we are making include:

- Ashville Road: replace the existing junction layout to a conventional give-way junction with wider pavements.
- Grove Green Road: remove the existing mini-roundabout at its junction with Ashville Road and resurface the existing raised table at its junction with Ashville Road and Dyers Hall Road.
- Relocate the zebra crossing from its current location north of Ashville Road to a new location between Ashville Road and Dyers Hall Road and provide three new Grove Green South CPZ bays outside Nos. 335-331 Grove Green Road E11.
- Remove two Grove Green South CPZ bays between Nos 323-325 Grove Green Road.

To keep the works on track and minimise disruption for everyone using these roads, on Tuesday 19th March from 8am Ashville Road will be closed to traffic at its junction with Grove Green Road for a period of two weeks. Access to Ashville Road from Grove Green Road will be still available through Central Avenue and Elm Road.

No parking signs and traffic management cones will be placed in the area, so please look out for these before you park – parking will still be available in adjacent roads so please use this space instead. If necessary, penalty notices will be issued and as a last resort vehicles will be removed and impounded if they are parked in a space that obstructs works. You can find contact details for the Council's parking enforcement contractors and details of their charges overleaf, should you need them.

While we appreciate that these works may be an inconvenience, we hope that you will bear with us over the next few weeks so we can complete these improvements as soon as possible. Our contractor Riney will be working to keep disruption to an absolute minimum. Thank you for your patience, in the

Penalty notice information

Penalty notice - £130 (discounted to £65 if paid within 14 days of issue) detail of payment will be on the back of the ticket.

Removal of vehicles and impounded – a charge of £65 for the Penalty notice and £200 for the release of the vehicle to be paid within the first 24 hours, after every 24 hour period a storage charge of £40 will be added. Collection of Impounded vehicles and payments for the release of a vehicle are to be made at the following address.
